CORONA RULES

For the journey to the event, each participant will receive a confirmation of participation in this sport event by email, and at the moment all participants in the event require a negative corona test that is not older than 72 hours, or a vaccination confirmation .

Furthermore, all legal requirements for pandemic containment apply at the event, which are specified by the Autonomous Province of Bolzano at this point in time. The participants themselves have to know the entry regulations of their own country for the return journey.

RACE BOATS

K1/C1

Only mass-produced PE plastic whitewater **Boat K1/C1** of serial production with a maximum length of 275cm and minimum weight of 18kg will be allowed to race. All kayaks must have a middle pillar in foam or plastic in the front and min. 2 Airbags in the Boat. No constructional changes that could impact the safety standards (e.g. handles, full plate footrests and pillars must not be removed!)

Race Controllers reserve the right to refuse certain types of kayaks from being used. Please ensure.

OC1:

Only mass-produced **open canoes** of serial production with a maximum length of 300cm will be allowed to race (they must be "open" and not a decked C1). Air bags or block foam wedges are obligatory. Race Controllers reserve the right to refuse certain types of open boats from being used. Please ensure;

- Open canoes must have a swim line attached to the boat and have suitable flotation with airbags or foam wedges.
- Electrical pumps are prohibited!

RACE INFO

- Parking at the start is limited, please share shuttles. Organise with other people to leave as many cars as possible at the finish (Football pitch Riffian)
- The start and finish are next to a busy cycle path. Please take care especially when carrying your boat on your shoulder.
- You need to inform the race secretary of any relevant medical conditions that may affect you during the race, so we can advise the safety and medical teams. Any personal medication must be carried with you in person or securely attached to the inside of your boat.
- On the morning of the race please leave in good time!! If you're late, we won't wait!
- There are 3 start groups

Start 1 - K1 Senior Men

Start 2 - K1 Senior Women /K1 Master Women/ K1 Junior Women

Start 3 - K1 Master Men / K1 Junior Men/ OC1 / Packraft R1

During the race please check who you are battling against, if the person is clearly in a different category, please let the faster boat pass.

- If you feel uncomfortable about continuing the race, wait in an eddie for the safety kayakers.
- If you do not start or do not finish the race you must inform the Race officials / Safety Team. We have to account for all athletes at the end of the race.
- Only the first 30 K1 or C1 senior men and first 5 women will go to the final. If you qualify for the final, but do not want to participate, you must inform the race secretary, so that the next fastest person can have your place.
- Team members must be of the same Nationality. The team race is the time of the Final course run together.
- Your race number is your lottery ticket for Saturday evening. If you do not return it we keep your €20 and you can't win any prizes!! (It's ok if it is still wet!)



GENERAL INFO

King of the Alps is only possible by the kind cooperation of the local people. Please be respectful to their culture and private land. Please park considerately to avoid blocking entrances, try not to hang around naked and do not cross the grass fields, keep to the footpaths.

The shower and toilet facilities are available for use from the local sports ground free of charge. Please keep them clean and tidy for the next person to use.
